## REPRESSION CO. LTD.

Today we are seeing a growing trend towards the "privatisation of war, repression and security". Iraq and Afghanistan are the crowning glories of this free market trend, the armies of occupation are greatly supplemented by a shadowy network of private security firms who carry out many duties that, in previous times and other places, would be done by regular soldiers. The cost to the taxpayer for these mercenaries is usually hidden, and in most cases enormous.

In the free market capitalist world this sort of contracting out of security has extended to other fields besides military operations. For various reasons most governments favour these "quangsas" (quasi non-governmental spy agencies), one is their fundamentalist faith in the "free market" and the belief in the illusion that all things will be more efficient and cheaper if provided by private contractors. Of course another reason being that most politicians have friends in the private sector and it is a case of you scratch my back and I'll scratch yours. There is also the fact "competing" for such government contracts takes place in a political atmosphere that could only be described at best, as dodgy. As we all know, the sort of atmosphere surrounding government contracts is inevitably and massively corrupt. Ex-politicians and, in this case ex-soldiers and policemen nod and wink their way through their old friendships and connections to land the big fish of free government money, "free market competition" my arse. The pig trough extends its funnels like an octopus..

There is also the fact that these type of private contracts are far less open to public scrutiny and control. ### A BAD APPLE OR A ROTTEN BARREL?

John McDonnell MP, chair of Labour Representation Committee, said: "Increasingly, evidence demonstrates policing of major demonstrations has got out of control and specialist police units have been acting with virtual impunity.

It's an on going saga of errors, brutality and corruption within the police force and police forces across the world..

It has just recently been announced that a group of Metropolitan Police officers are under investigation on allegations of subjecting suspects to torture, (waterboarding, simulated drowning) there are also allegations that they fabricated evidence and stole suspects property. This follows on from the brutal death of Ian Tomlinson and hundreds of complaints of police brutality at the G20 demonstrations in April 2009.

Then there are the cases of innocent people being shot dead by the police, some with mental health problems and others for going to work via the London underground and another for having a Glasgow accent and carrying a coffee table leg.

Over in the US a 72 year old woman was stopped for doing 60mph in a 45mph zone, when she refused to sign the speeding ticket she was stunned twice by the the police officer using his taser. The old woman falling to the ground was recorded on video.

To all those who for some strange reason still think it is the odd bad cop, or the one rotten apple in the barrel, the crucial message they need to grasp is that these are not bugs in the system; *this is the system*, the barrel is rotten.

## **MER PISH FAE BAMPOT BUREAUCRATS**

Fresh from Culture & Sport and other Tendering fiascos, Glasgow City Council has tendered out all money advice from July 1<sup>st</sup>. Far from expanding advice this is leading to less advice, for the hard-pressed citizens reeling from the "credit crunch", loss of jobs and mounting debt.

Instead of individual grants to approved Advice Centres, we have a situation where the Council is giving the £9 million, over 3 years, from the Scottish Executive to 5 area based Consortia plus a central specialist/Legal fund, homeless provision and an advice helpline (to *Citizen Direct* not *The Samaritans!*).

Each Consortia will have to fund a "Development worker" on top of existing back room staff to deal with all the paper work. This will be at the expense of front-line services. The Consortia will hope to pick up additional advice posts from other sources, to help cope with an existing demand that sees queues outside Centres on drop-in days, and waiting lists for appointments at 4-8 weeks.

There is no extra money from Council sources, and Centres are closing or downsizing as a direct result.

In the South-West of Glasgow, the Consortia of 3 have excluded a community based Information Centre of over 28 years service, in *Ladymuir*, North Pollok. The Committee of local people running the project have been unable to attract alternative funds, and 4 staff are set to lose their jobs on 30<sup>th</sup> June. The funds to pay for increased bureaucracy, legal and monitoring costs are being paid for, from 3 front-line advice posts and one part-time clerical post sacrificed at the Alter of Bureaucracy!

Despite the usual buck passing and tea-and-sympathy the Politicians have been Nae use. They have come over as all powerless, in the face of the Senior DRS Management at 229 George Street advancing their crazy scheme. Between Quarter, and a Half of a Million has been paid out in consultancy fees to the likes of Blake Stevenson, by Steve Inch and his DRS balloons. Yet the Councillors rubber stamped it without a whimper at the appropriately named Executive Sub Committee in late April.

Now to cap it all the Council are worried that by setting up these new Consortia, the Inland Revenue is threatening to slap on VAT, where no such charge was made before against individual Charitable Advice organisations. This would mean huge cuts in advice services on top of those in this Tendering process.

It all amounts to Complete Pish, schemes dreamt up by Bureaucrats to the detriment of the punters. Can anybody be really surprised!

## **THE VICIOUS MARRIAGE OF STATE AND CAPITALISM. OUR HISTORY- GEORGE SQUARE 1919.**

As the impact of the global financial and economic crisis hits millions of workers and workers everywhere feel the full impact of surging unemployment on their families and communities, now more than ever we need working class solidarity through grassroots union organisation.

Despite the formal recognition by governments of trade union rights, this year, as in the past, sees continuous and harsh violations of fundamental trade union rights. Countries where widespread anti-union practices have continued include: Colombia, Burma, Belarus, Sudan, Zimbabwe, Swaziland, Iran, Pakistan, the Philippines, Honduras and Guatemala. There are many other countries where interference in trade union activities have been reported, Iraq, Kuwait, Latvia, Kyrgyzstan, the Russian Federation, Turkey, Venezuela, among others. Despite measures in some Middle East countries and Gulf States, migrant workers are still denied trade union rights in many countries. The situation of domestic workers, mostly women and migrant workers in the Middle East and the Gulf States as well as some African and Asian countries, is unacceptable. Companies continued to take advantage of poor legislation and weak implementation to undermine workers' rights. Here in the UK we still struggle under the anti-union legislation introduced in the Thatcher era.

In 2008, at least 76 labour activists were killed as a result of their actions for workers' rights. Latin America remains the deadliest continent for trade unionists with over 66 murdered. 49 Colombian trade unionists lost their lives (including 16 union leaders, 4 of whom were women), a 25% increase over 2007. Trade unionists were also killed in Guatemala (9), Honduras (3), Venezuela (4). In Asia, at least 6 murders were reported (Nepal and the Philippines), as well as 3 in Africa (Nigeria, Tunisia and Zimbabwe), 1 in the Middle East (Iraq). China still bans independent trade unions.

This year thousands of trade unionists and workers were dismissed for participating in strike actions or protests; thousands more were harassed or discriminated against and hundreds arrested. Denial and other violations of labour and union rights are common in export processing areas, for example, Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Swaziland, Bangladesh, Kenya, Mauritius and Pakistan. Reports of assassinations, abductions, arrests and imprisonments, as well as death threats, dismissals, harassments, acts of discrimination and intimidation against trade unionists are widespread.

The ongoing globalisation of the world economy coupled with the financial and economic crisis puts pressure on labour markets, working conditions and workers' rights everywhere. Workers continue to be threatened by employers with relocation, outsourcing and downsizing, with inevitable negative consequences of their trade union rights.

New forms of employment relationships are also affecting fundamental rights. The use of bogus self-employment as well as subcontractors or labour agencies is increasing in industrialised and developing countries. Yet, millions of trade unionists and labour activists around the world continue to fight for workers' rights, sometimes at the risk of losing their own lives or livelihoods. Now more than ever we should remember, "An Injury to One is an Injury to All!"



A Glasgow protest that brought the troops on to the streets of Glasgow. It was then, and still is the largest military action by the British state against its own people. The day became known as Bloody Friday.

### **FREEDOM.**
